

BACT Guide on How to Make a Complaint

Club Based Teams

Game incidents should be raised with the black shirt referees, court supervisors or other BACT officials at the court. Game incidents relate to any conduct of players, coaches, spectators, or officials before, during or after the game inside the stadium or surrounds.

BACT cannot overturn the on-court decisions of referees, including suspensions received under the Infringement System.

The only on-court incidents that can be overturned by BACT are cases of mistaken identity, where a foul has been attributed to the wrong player on the score sheet.

Players:

In the event that game incidents are grossly mishandled by the game-day officials, players should raise their concerns with a coach, team manager or club coordinator.

Coaches:

In the event that game incidents are grossly mishandled by the game-day officials, coaches should raise their concerns with a club coordinator.

Parents/Spectators:

In the event that game incidents are grossly mishandled by the game-day officials, parents and spectators should raise their concerns with a coach, team manager or club coordinator.

Club Coordinators:

Club coordinators have the responsibility of fielding complaints from their members in addition to any complaints they may have of their own. They should consider all the information reported to them in the complaint and consider if there is a way of dealing with the complaint internally or if they need to lodge an official complaint with BACT. If the club contact needs to forward the complaint to BACT, they should fill out the form below:

Senior Social Teams
