



Canberra Classic Rules 2025

Competition Rules Invitational

Timing

- ✚ Warm up between 5-10 minutes
- ✚ 10 Minute running clock – The last 2 minutes of the last quarter will be fully timed within 10 points.
- ✚ 14 & 24 second shot clock.

Time Outs

- ✚ 2-Time outs per team in the first half, 3- Time outs per team in the second half – The clock will stop for the duration of the time out.

Breaks

- ✚ 1 minute at the 1st & 3rd quarter break.
- ✚ 3 minutes at half time break.

Extra Time

- ✚ No draws – Invitational 3-minute extra time will be played until a result is obtained, which will be fully timed.

Basketball

- ✚ Teams must supply their own warm-up balls; match balls will be provided by a BACT staff member.
- ✚ Size 7 basketball will be used for all men's games in the competition.
- ✚ Size 6 basketball will be used for all women's games in the competition.

Officials & Duty

- ✚ BACT will provide Officials and duty for all games in the competition.

Competition Rules A - C Grade

Timing

- ✚ 10 Minute running clock – The last 2 minutes of the last quarter will be fully timed.
- ✚ No 24 second shot clock.



Time Outs

- ✚ 2 time out per team, per half – The clock will stop for the duration of the time out.

Breaks

- ✚ 1 minute at the 1st & 3rd quarter break.
- ✚ 3 minutes at half time.

Extra Time – there must be a result. (No draws)

- ✚ A grade and B grade will play 2 minutes of extra time, the game will be played until a result is obtained
- ✚ Extra time will be fully timed.

Basketball

- ✚ Teams must supply their own warm-up balls; match balls will be provided by a BACT staff member.
- ✚ Size 7 basketball will be used for all men's games in the competition.
- ✚ Size 6 basketball will be used for all women's games in the competition.

Officials and Duty

- ✚ BACT will provide Officials for all games in the competition.
- ✚ Teams will be REQUIRED to supply someone to do bench on their own games in the competition.

**FIBA Rules apply for both competitions.*
