Nominations must be received by **5pm, Friday 17 January 2025**. Forms completed incorrectly or not in accordance with the A.C.T. Basketball Inc. Constitution will be deemed to be invalid.

Nominees are invited to submit a copy of their CV and a 1-page (A4) biography, containing their accomplishments, vision, purpose and objective as a director. This will be circulated to all members prior to the meeting. Nominees will not be permitted to speak or verbally present at the Annual General Meeting *with respect to the election process*.

ELIGIBILITY TO BE A DIRECTOR

Extracted from ACT Basketball Inc Constitution:

12.2 Eligibility

A person who is bankrupt or who has been convicted, whether in or outside the ACT, of:

- (a) an indictable offence in relation to the promotion, formation or management of a body corporate; or
- (b) a serious criminal offence punishable by imprisonment for a period of 3 months or more;

is ineligible to be elected or appointed as President or as a Director, unless leave has been granted by the Supreme Court pursuant to the Act, and permission is granted by all other Directors.

The President or Directors shall not hold any Official Position (including being an employee of) the Association or of a Club, during the period of their term (called a Disqualifying Position), unless permission is granted in writing by all other Directors.

A President or Director who accepts a Disqualifying Position must notify the other Directors of that fact immediately and, unless written permission is granted pursuant to this Rule 12.2, Rule 12.15(d) applies.

Persons who have been employed by the Association or have been in a financial relationship with the Association (for example suppliers or contractors) are not eligible to be elected or appointed as President or as Directors within two years of such employment or relationship ceasing, unless permission is granted in writing by a majority of Directors.

12.3 Nomination for election

A Full Member or a Director may nominate a person for election as President or as an Elected Director.

Nominations must be in the form prescribed by the Association from time to time.

Nominations must be seconded by a Full Member or a Director.

Nominations must be lodged with the Chief Operating Officer not less than 14 days prior to the annual general meeting.
